## New Painting System for UZ Tap-Changers

We have developed a new painting system for UZ tap-changers. The whole tap-changer, both outside and inside, and the motor-drive mechanism, are painted in the same light grey colour. At the moment, we have selected three light grey colours as standard.

The most important benefit from production point of view, is that it is not necessary to mask parts of the tap-changer during painting. That in turn saves time, and from customer point of view, the delivery times can be shorter.
