First installation of the new cable box bushing

ABB Components has delivered the first new dry type cable box bushings. The bushings, rated 123 kV and 2000 A, were delivered to the customer in Thailand only 6 weeks after order registration.

The new dry bushings are free from partial discharge, with a very low dissipation factor to ensure trouble free operation over the transformer life time.

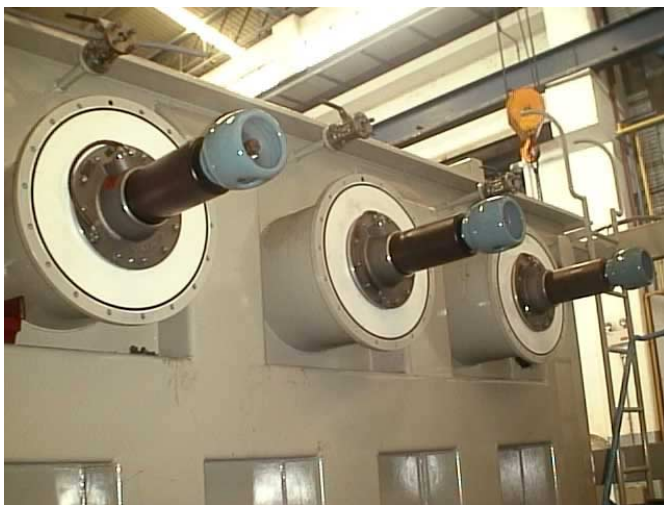

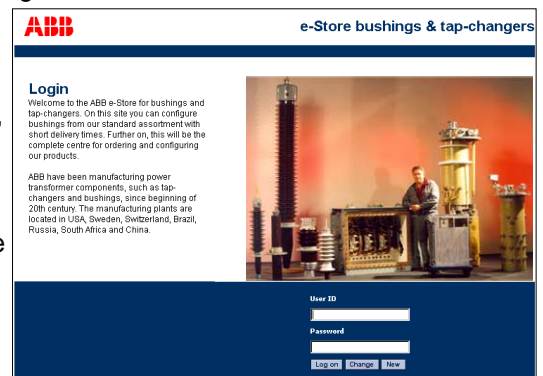

Documents on CD

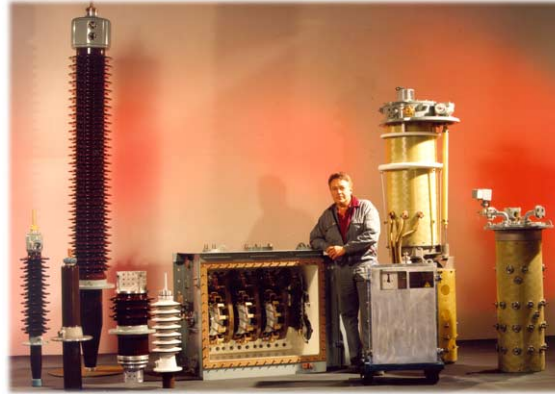
